The State Board of Law Examiners, after careful consideration of their qualifications, has by report to the Court recommended that the Uniform Bar Exam Transfer applicants (“UBT applicants”) named on Exhibit A attached hereto be admitted to the Bar, conditioned upon satisfaction of the requirements of Maryland Rules 19-204 (Character Review), 19-212 (Maryland Law Component), and 19-213 (Qualifying MPRE Score Required).

It is thereupon the 2nd day of May 2022, by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, ORDERED that the Board’s recommendation be ratified, subject to the conditions therein stated, on the 1st day of June 2022, unless exceptions to the Board’s recommendation of any UBT applicant be filed on or before said date, provided a copy of this Order be published on the Maryland Judiciary Website no later than 5 days after the date of entry and remains on the website until ratification.
