FINAL ORDER OF RATIFICATION

This Court's October 6, 2022, Order *Nisi* was entered and posted on the Judiciary's website pursuant to Rule 19-211(b)(2). That Order identified individuals who the State Board of Law Examiners recommended for admission to the Bar of Maryland, subject to each applicant's satisfaction of identified conditions. The Order further provided that it would be ratified as to each identified applicant, effective on November 6, 2022, unless the Court received an exception as to that applicant by that date. No exceptions to the State Board's recommendation have been filed as to any applicant.
